

## ESRA Certification of UGRA courses in different countries

The aim of this project is to develop a well-designed program for regional anaesthesia courses, that are ESRA certified. In this manner any anaesthetist may gain access to high quality courses with identical content across ESRA.

The advantages of this project are the following:

- Equal quality of RA courses in Europe

- Pan-European exchange of experts/ speakers

The certification of courses was already done in the past through EDRA. No system is currently in place for such recognition. Considering the complexity of the project, it was suggested to start with cadaver workshops which may be easier to standardize.
